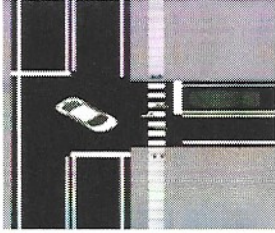


Pedestrian Safety Star Cards
