Pedestrian Crossing



School Crossing

When you see this sign:

Motorists must be careful of students
crossing the street to go to school



Push Button



Railroad Crossing



Yield to Pedestrians



No Pedestrian Traffic

When you see this sign:

DO NOT CROSS



Sign Colors

RED - Stop, Prohibited Action Signs (stop, yield, do not enter)

Yellow - Caution, Warning Signs (two-way traffic, merge, railroad crossing)

Blue - Motorist Service Signs (hospital, gas, camping, telephone, food)

Green (light) - Go, Proceed

Black and White, with a Red Circle and Bar through the middle - Guide signs (no trucks, no right turn, no U-turn)

Important Vocabulary

Transportation - A way of getting from place to place

Destination - Where you want to go

Departure Time - When you are leaving

Point of Departure - The place from which you are leaving

Arrival Time - When you are arriving
