# Examples of Etiquette

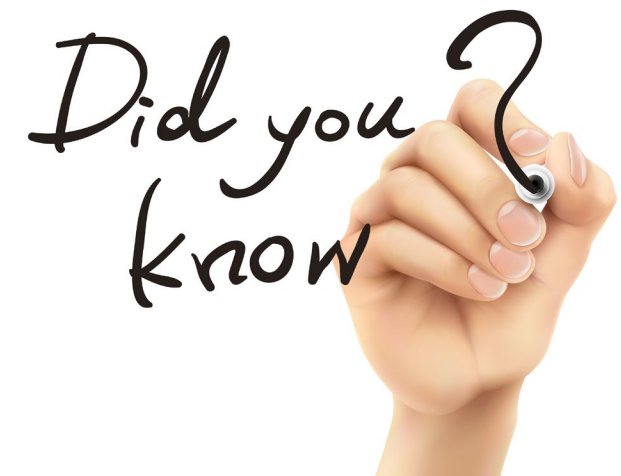
## Table Etiquette

- When it comes time to apply to college or for a job, email skills will most likely be necessary. Therefore, an understanding of "email etiquette" is worthy of discussion.



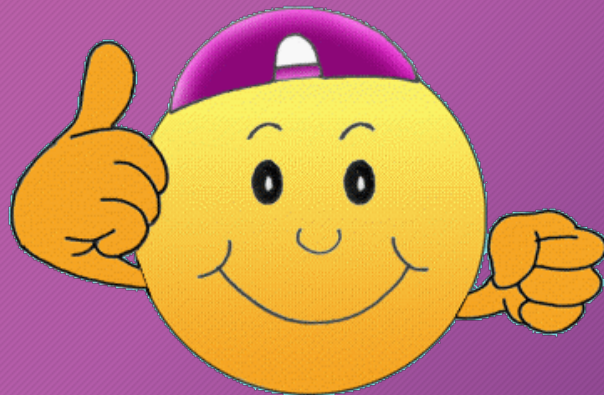
# Translating Text Activity
