



Topic: Online Internet Safety

1. Open PowerPoint titled “Online Safety”

Discuss

- a. Slides #1
  - a. Ask the person you support are they familiar with Social Media?
  - b. What kind of Social Media do they use?
2. Watch “Super Realistic Online Safety” Video
3. Discuss:
  1. Do you think Maggie made a bad choice by sending those photos in the dressing room?
  - 2. Reiterate to the person you support that nude pictures of kids and teens are inappropriate!**
  3. Let’s take some time to ask;
    1. What kind of pictures do you post on the web? Are they appropriate or inappropriate?
    2. Have you ever seen someone post an inappropriate post before? How did you handle that? Did you report the post?
  4. Why is it important to keep your pictures private?
- 4. If the person you support has a social media. This is a great opportunity to support them by making sure they have their privacy settings set to their liking.**
5. Slide #3
  1. Go Through Slide #3 with the person you support
    1. Discuss
      1. Who is in your Personal Network?
        1. List 3-5
      2. Who is in your Professional Network
        1. List 3-5
      3. Give the person you support an example of Personal social media account (Facebook, Instagram, Pinterest?). Provide an example of a professional social media account (Linked in). If comfortable sharing, explain to

the person you support how you as staff see the difference between personal and professional networks.

5. Go Through Slides #4 - #11

1. Discuss

- a. Have you heard of Linked in before?
- b. Do you have a linked in?
- c. Do you have an Instagram?
- d. Do you know how to use personal social media accounts like Facebook and Instagram?

6. Slide #12 Beware of Spam

1. Ask the person you support;

- a. What is Scam or Spam?
- b. Have you ever experienced a Scam before?
- c. Have you ever received a Spam email before?

1. Discuss

1. Have you ever experienced Phishing before?
2. How do you keep track of your log in information for different sites?
3. What should you do if you receive a phishing email?

10. Slides #17 and #18

1. Go Over Slides with the person you support.

1. Discuss

- a. Have you ever tried online dating before?
- b. Let’s Brainstorm which specific information someone should keep private while online dating.

11. Play “Share Jumper” on Digital Passport

1. *“Posting on the internet can be as fun as jumping on a trampoline” Sharing the right info can send you flying high. Sharing the wrong info can make you tumble and fall. Can you make the right choices?”*
2. Instructions.
