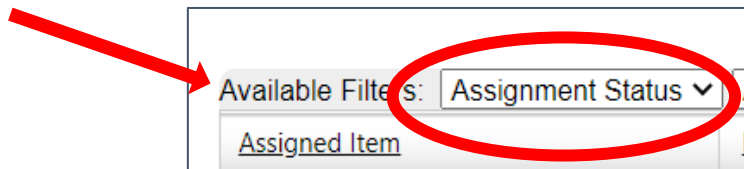


How to Find a List of all the Elsevier Courses

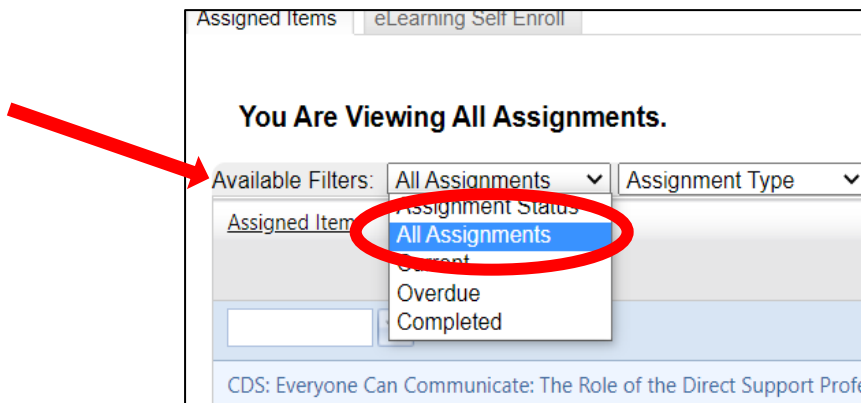
- Step 1: Log into Elsevier and get to the page that lists your assignments. If you've already completed all the courses, you can go to the "eLearning" tab near the top and select "My eLearning Lessons."



- Step 2: Find the "Assignment Status" tab near the middle of the screen.



- Step 3: Select "All Assignments" for a list of courses you've completed and ones you still have left.



- Step 4: Click on the name of the course you want.
