Our Team

- Our team of business and disability experts help people live full lives with jobs, friendships, fun, and personal growth.
- Our Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) help remove obstacles and support people in their communities.
- We share through webinars and conferences and work with Maryland groups to improve access, funding, and training.



Why SEEC?

- We provide personal support, job opportunities and fun activities to help people live happy, independent lives in their communities.
- We work with people, families, staff, and the community to make sure everyone feels in charge of their own life.
- We provide the highest caliber of community-based, person-directed services



Community Engagement (CE)

- Community Engagment helps people enjoy life through volunteering, learning, and fun activities.
- We believe everyone should feel included and reach their full potential.
- Our coaches help create a schedule based on each person's interests and goals.
- These activities build skills, grow independence, and prepare people for future jobs.



Employment Services (ES)

- Employment Services helps people find jobs that match their skills.
- We work with local businesses instead of using job ads.
- These businesses offer flexible jobs and schedules.
- Some jobs are personalized for our job seekers.
- This helps people succeed, keep their jobs, grow in their careers, and earn money.



Transition Services (TS)

- Transition Services supports people moving to new stages in life, such as from school to work or living on their own.
- Employment consultants work with people and their families every step of the way.
- Project SEARCH gives young adults job experience through internships with places like the Montgomery County Government, and Hilton Hotels.
- These internships are supported by Ivymount School, the Maryland Division of Rehabilitation Services, the Maryland Developmental Disabilities Administration, DC Public Schools, and the DC Rehabilitation Services Administration.



Supported Living (SL)

- Supported Living helps people choose and keep a home that fits their needs, interests, and dreams.
- We make sure they feel safe, comfortable, and at home.
- Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) provide help, from occasional visits to full 24-hour support for those who need it.
- Our services help people be independent, respected, and included in their community.



Personal Supports (PS)

- Personal Supports provides daytime services and overnight supports
- PS helps people learn and use daily life skills while living at home or on their own.
- Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) help people with meal planning, grocery shopping, budgeting, community activities, and paying bills.



Behavior Support Services (BSS)

- Behavior Support Services are designed to help people develop positive behaviors, improve social and emotional well-being, and enhance their independence in their community.

What's Included:

- Assessment – A behavioral specialist meets with you to understand your needs and create a support plan.
- Behavior Support Plan (BSP) – A personalized plan with strategies to promote positive behaviors and reduce challenges.
- Training – Support for you, your family, and staff to implement the plan effectively.
- Ongoing Monitoring & Adjustments – Check-ins to update the plan based on your progress and needs.
